

RESOLUTION NO. 1 of 2024

TITLE: REFERRALS TO THE COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Schoharie County Planning Commission (SCPC) is scheduled to meet once per month, typically on the first Monday of a month, and

WHEREAS, New York State General Municipal Law 239-m 4(b) gives a County Planning Commission (CPC) 30 days from the receipt to make a recommendation, and

WHEREAS, New York State General Municipal Law 239-m 1(d) permits a CPC to adopt rules related to the receipt of referrals provided any such rule does not require receipt of a referral for a period greater than twelve (12) days in advance of a meeting, now therefore be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the SCPC requires receipt of a referral at least ten (10) business days prior, not to exceed twelve (12) calendar days, to a meeting for that referral to be considered on-time. Nothing herein shall limit the ability of the SCPC to act upon referrals received fewer than ten (10) business days or twelve (12) calendar days before the date of any meeting of the Commission.
