Engineer Requirement Under New York State Education Law

Various provisions of the New York State Public Health Law, New York State Sanitary Code, and the Schoharie County Sanitary Code require the submission of plans for approval to this department for new or modified facilities for (1) sewage disposal systems serving commercial establishments such as restaurants, trailer parks, campsites, schools, stores, apartments, etc.; (2) realty subdivisions, whether or not they are served by public water or sewerage facilities; (3) water treatment and distribution; (4) swimming pools; and (5) food service establishments.

The New York State Education Law requires that all plans, specifications, plots, and reports to be filed with public officials must be stamped with the seal of the licensed professional engineer, architect and/or land surveyor who prepared them. Only a licensed professional engineer or architect is permitted to prepare that portion of a plan, which involves the design of water supply or sewage disposal systems. All plans must be accompanied by the appropriate application and plan review fee.

For your reference, see the attached alphabetical list of engineers who are licensed to prepare certain plans in accordance with the New York State Education Law and have submitted plans to the Schoharie County Department of Health in the recent past. It should not be regarded as a complete list since there are numerous other licensed individuals and firms well qualified to do this work.
