

EMERGENCY ORDERS

Local Emergency Order for: Schoharie County :

I, William Federice, the Chief Executive
of Schoharie County, in accordance with a declaration of a State of

Emergency issued on March 16, 2020, 2020 and pursuant to Section 24 of the

New York State Executive Law, do hereby order:

1. Schoharie County will temporarily suspend current Policy and Procedures to follow alternate staffing and compensation measures to protect the safety of our employees and visitors during the COVID-19 pandemic.
2. Schoharie County will temporarily suspend current procurement and administrative procedures to expedite emergency purchases and service delivery. The purchasing agent shall seek County Administrator (or designee) sign-off for necessary budget modifications to change appropriation amounts, suspend normal contracting procedures and allow other irregular practices. County Administrator shall provide a weekly report of all such decisions to the Chairman of the Board (or designee) as a method of oversight.
3. Board of Supervisors meetings and committee meetings may be suspended or conducted through telephone or other electronic means.
4. All Schoharie County Schools shall be closed as of March 16, 2020 to help slow the spread of COVID-19.


This order shall take effect March 16, 2020 at 11:00 am
