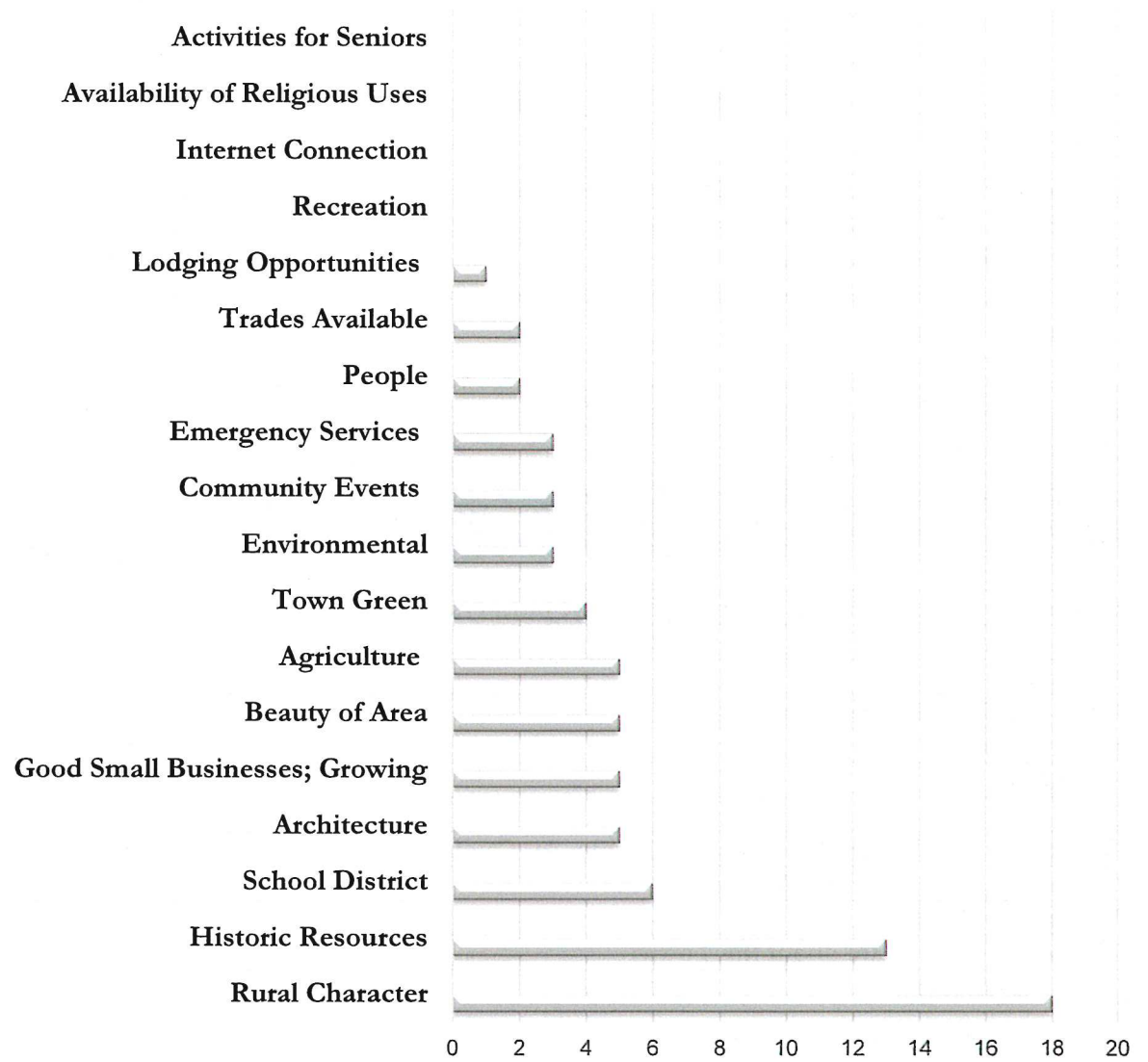


SWOT Analysis Results

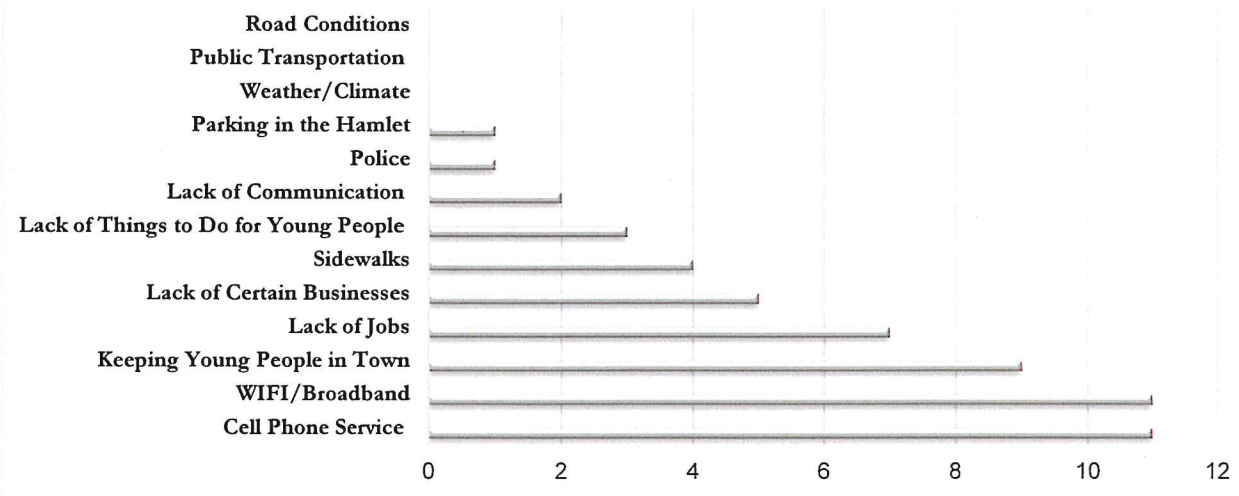

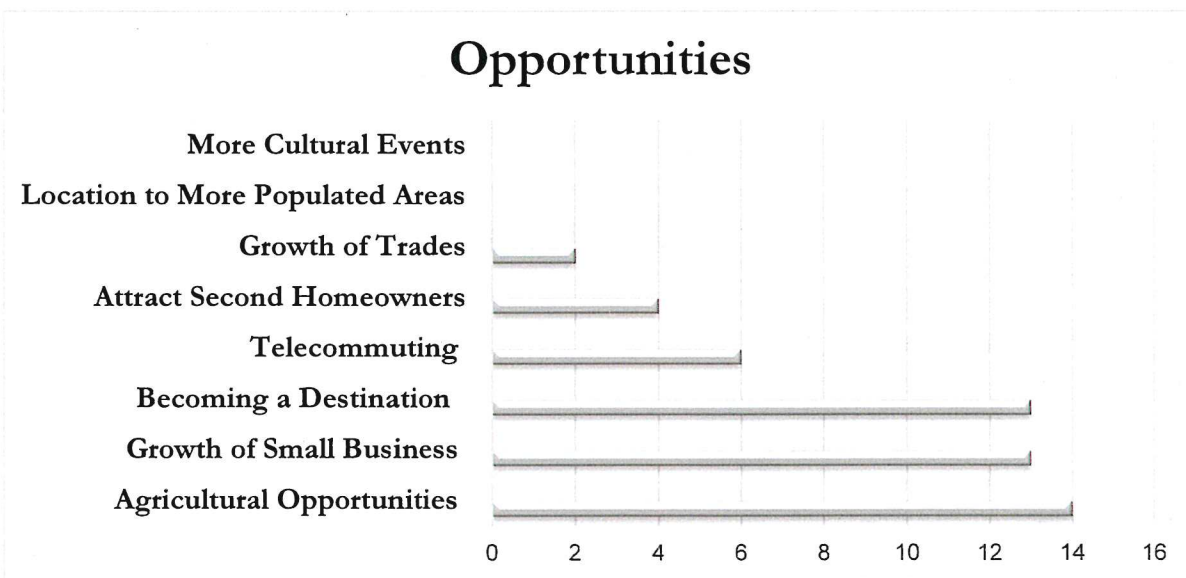
