- 1) Minimum lot size if lot can support on-site septic and water in accordance with the Schoharie County Department of Health Regulations.
- 2) \*Distance of setback shall be measured from edge of highway or shall be specified distances plus twenty-five (25) feet from the highway centerline.
- 3) A minimum of ten percent (10%) greenspace is required for all lots.
- 4) Lot depth may be varied when a cluster or conservation subdivision design is required or proposed.
- 5) Cupolas and other roof ornaments may extend above the roof height.
