Review Revised Agricultural Land Map, Lillian brought several maps. For clarity Brian made one map showing ag district, active ag use, ag exemptions. A separate map shows soils, wetlands and slopes. It was suggested to overlay parcels on this map. The committee also thought it would be helpful to add the names of roads on the maps. These maps will be included in the plan. Lillian indicated that data on the location of the Tennessee Gas line is not available. It was suggested to change the codes to better highlight the land in active agricultural use.

<u>Prioritization of Agricultural Lands</u> – The maps show areas with good soil, in active use but that is not in an ag district. This would be a priority. The committee could recommend that those landowners be approached and informed about inclusion in the ag district for state protections.

KARL WESTPHAL 872-1687 Economic Impact Study Update – Michelle introduced updated draft of report complied by David Cox. With maps complete some specific Town of Wright data can be included in this report. Since the data collected was based on full parcels when possibly only partial lots are in active ag use, this distinction should be noted in the report in an effort to best reflect the data as accurate as possible. Michele shared specific numbers about Town of Wright acreage. Land of local importance needs to be an estimate since whole and partial parcels were used. Laura suggested using the specific data available and then to describe (not using same categories) the land of local importance. Brian will continue to revise this report and will submit a final draft for the next meeting.
